

## Timeline for Subject Selection

Hastings Secondary College comprises two Year 7 to 12 campuses; Port Macquarie Campus and Westport Campus.

Our college is one of the largest providers of secondary education on the mid north coast of NSW with over 1200 students, a college teaching staff of 108 and support staff of over 35. The college offers enhanced learning opportunities for students in Years 11 and 12 (Stage 6), including our highly successful cross campus program.

The program maintains and extends the range of subject choices available to students. Students are able to choose from the full range of subjects available at both campuses, including all Higher School Certificate extension courses in English, Mathematics, History and Science. In addition, students from both campuses can combine to form a viable class which otherwise may not be able to run on an individual campus timetable.

The college provides transport for cross campus students who access courses at another campus at no cost. Hastings Secondary College offers an outstanding range of co-curricular activities in all years, made possible by our dedicated staff and quality facilities, which are accessible to all students at the college.
